Paul’s sermon to the supreme judges of Athens on Mars Hill contains a great fundamental truth that we often overlook. The people of Athens had erected altars to their many gods. They had even erected an altar to “An Unknown God.” Paul tried to make known the God that was unknown to them. Paul stated several truths that apply to us today.

- We should seek God. He is near to us and possible to find. We should search for Him diligently and accurately. We should learn of His love for us. We should learn of His desires and commandments.
- We need to know God because it is in Him that we have life. He formed us and sustains us.
- We need to know Him because it is in Him that we find our being – our true purpose in life that brings satisfaction and peace to us.

As Christians, we are God’s children. We have a rich inheritance that is powerful and gives us hope. Many people go through life without knowing God and are unaware of the inheritance God’s children have waiting for them. In God we have everything. Without God, we have nothing.
